





















Carriage of Lithium Type Batteries Guidelines to Rules - Effective January 1, 2008

1. Although you may carry some devices and installed batteries in checked baggage, carrying them in carry-on baggage, when practicable, is preferred. In checked baggage, ensure that devices remain switched off, either by built-in switch/trigger locks, by taping the activation switch in the "off" position, or by other appropriate measures.
2. Be sure to take protective measures to prevent against short-circuits. If original packaging is not available, effectively insulate battery terminals by isolating spare batteries from contact with other batteries and metal. Place tape across the battery's contacts and put each battery in its own protective case or plastic bag.
3. All lithium type batteries containing more than 25 grams of lithium or equivalent are prohibited from carriage on all passenger aircraft.
